



## **EMBASSY OF PAKISTAN** **SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2020**

The Embassy of Pakistan based in Sofia is pleased to announce the SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2020 for eligible Bulgarian students. The Program is open to individuals enrolled in academic curricula pertaining to humanities, management, technology, science & its affiliations and economics. History, linguistics, tourism and other fields of instruction will also be accorded substantial weight.

The stipulations of the internship tenure are enumerated below:

***Designation: Student Intern as support staff (2 Slots)***  
***Application Date: On or preceding Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020***  
***Commencement: Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020***  
***Duration: One month***  
***Termination: Monday, 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020***  
***Work Schedule: 1000 to 1700 hours, Mondays through Fridays***  
***Mode Of Submission: Online access will be [parepsofia@mofa.gov.pk](mailto:parepsofia@mofa.gov.pk)***

The Program is premised on a honorary or voluntary capacity. It does not carry monetary or other remunerations – partially or wholly - for the entirety of the mandate. Nevertheless, a Certificate of Experience will be awarded upon the successful culmination of the internship tenure.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

Only students of educational institutions sanctioned by the National Evaluation and Accreditation Agency to the Ministry of Education and Science are eligible for the SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2020. It is essential for applicants to furnish a document manifesting enrolment and accompanied by a reference letter from the faculty/institute.

### **Skill Set Entailed**

Fluency in English is a prerequisite as well as the ability to translate documents from Bulgarian to English and vice versa. Competence in terms of familiarity and aptitude in computer applications is welcome. Yet another quality is the propensity for inquiry & research.

### **Internee Predisposition**

The selected candidates must display a strong penchant for organization, punctuality, versatility, politeness and the underlying sense of belonging to a team. Courtesy, perseverance and uniformity in communications with private, corporate and official entities will be expected.

### **Foremost Duty**

The internees will be assigned independent work stations with daily tasks delineated by the Ambassador and Deputy Head of Mission.
